Venus and Serena Williams are the world's number one women tennis players and in 2001 they made history when they were the first sisters to play together in the US Open in 100 years.

Their success wasn't easy. The sisters started by hitting old tennis balls against a wall in Los Angeles when they were four years old. The Williams family wasn't rich and they didn't buy expensive tennis equipment or lessons. While the girls were training, their father (who was their coach) learned about tennis from books.

When Venus was nine and Serena was eight, they played in their first tennis tournament. Both girls were in the final and Venus beat her younger sister. Soon after that their father took Venus and Serena out of junior competitions so they had more time for their school work.

When the girls were teenagers they went back to international tennis. They are both great athletes and play very strong tennis so they quickly climbed to the top of the game. The sisters are now winning all the big competitions and it is not unusual to see them playing against each other in the final of Wimbledon, the US or French Open.
